Responsibilities

- Recruit, train and manage fellows and volunteers to conduct direct voter contact. ● Coordinate volunteer events included but not limited to in person canvasses, phone banks and community meetings.
- Utilize a number of tactics and tools to hit daily and weekly metric goals including but not limited to phone recruitment, texting, high traffic canvassing, canvassing and tabling.
- Recruit, manage and train volunteer leaders to execute a large scale GOTV.
- Other responsibilities as assigned.

Required Qualifications

- Previous campaign experience as staff or volunteer preferred but not required.
- Willingness to work in the field office and in the community you are assigned.
- Commitment to electing all Democrats up and down the ballot.
- Flexible, adaptable and solutions-oriented.
- Must have access to a cell phone, vehicle and ability to relocate if necessary.

This is an hourly position starting at \$17.34 per hour. Organizers will start out with a 55 hour work week with hours expected to increase at the start of general election early voting. This is a Union position. This position includes a full benefits package of health, vision, and dental insurance coverage.
