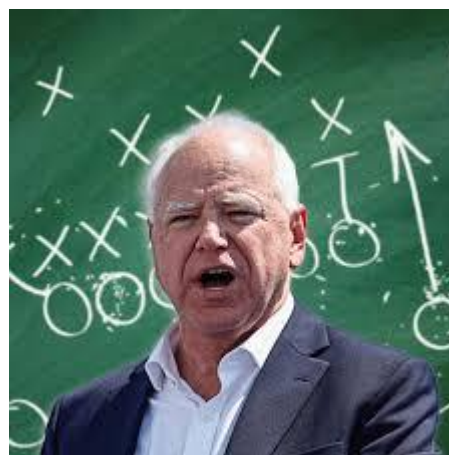

SLOTKIN FOR U.S. SENATE

Elissa Slotkin earned a bachelor of arts in sociology from Cornell University in 1998 followed by a master of international affairs from Columbia University's School of International and Public Affairs in 2003.

Slotkin was recruited by the Central Intelligence Agency after graduate school. Fluent in Arabic and Swahili, she served three tours in Iraq as a CIA analyst. During the George W. Bush administration, she worked on the Iraq portfolio for the National Security Council. During Barack Obama's presidency, she worked for the State Department and the Department of Defense. Slotkin was acting assistant secretary of defense for international security affairs from 2015 to 2017.

She is currently U.S. representative for Michigan's 7th congressional district.

Callie Barr was born and raised in Traverse City and Cheboygan, with her family roots going back five generations. (Her great-grandmother taught in the local one-room schoolhouse.) Callie graduated as valedictorian from Cheboygan High School.

After September 11, Callie's future husband and high school sweetheart, Matt, enlisted in the U.S. Marine Corps and served two tours in Iraq.

Callie raised two girls and eventually was caregiver for Matt after he suffered combat injuries, including post-traumatic stress and a traumatic brain injury.

In 2010, Callie received her bachelor's degree in secondary education from Central Michigan University.

Motivated by the desire to advocate for policy changes at the federal level, Callie went on to receive a law degree, graduating with honors from University of Michigan Law School. After graduation, Callie worked to connect veterans to free legal services.

Callie believes we deserve a representative who, instead of playing to political extremes, actually gets things done for Upper and Northern Michigan.

MICHIGAN SUPREME COURT CANDIDATES

Bolden and Thomas – *Nominated by Michigan Democratic Party*

*In Michigan, the **People** elect their Supreme Court justices.*

You must individually cast your vote in the non-partisan section of your ballot.

Stright ticket voting does not include the non-partisan section.

- ➔ Each major party nominates candidates at their convention or through primaries
- ➔ At the statewide election, on the Non-partisan section of the ballot, voters elect justices.

This is called “the Michigan method”. No other state uses this method.

Kimberly Ann Thomas

Kimberly Ann Thomas is an experienced trial and appellate lawyer and law professor at the University of Michigan Law School. Kimberly directs the Juvenile Justice Clinic, where she teaches students the ethical practice of law and works to improve the lives of Michigan youth.

She has been recognized for her service by the Criminal Defense Attorneys of Michigan.



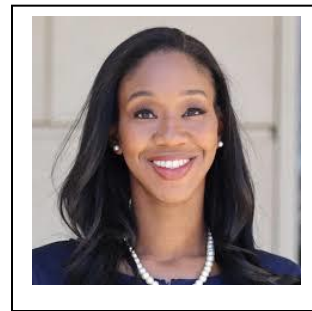

Kyra Harris Bolden Incumbent

Justice Bolden was nominated to the court by Gov. Gretchen Whitmer in 2022.

She earned bachelor’s degree from Grand Valley State University and her Juris Doctorate from the University Detroit Mercy School of Law.



While a member of the Michigan House of Representatives Kyra focused on criminal justice reform, crafting and passing bipartisan bills to protect survivors of sexual violence.

Her awards include Detroit NAACP’s Ida B. Wells Freedom and Justice Award; Michigan Chronicle’s 2023 Woman of the Year Award; Crain’s Detroit 40 under 40 Award.

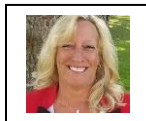
